Recycle Program at Westminster School is held the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month

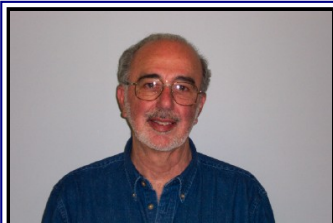
