Membership Activities

Council 4030 welcomes two new members. We are pleased to announce that **Michael Krenerich** and **Paul Fousier** have recently completed the first degree. Invite your friends and family that are not currently members of council 4030 to join.

2005 Membership Survey:

Surveys were mailed to 269 members currently on the 4030 roster. As of 3/11/05 we have received 61 total replies (22.6% response) 56 surveys filled out / 5 deceased or transferred. It is not too late to send in your survey.

Results of the 56 surveys:

- 1) The 56 members who replied are comprised of 16% 1st, 60% 2nd/3rd and 23% 4th Degree.
- 2) Meeting Attendance: 27% Attend monthly, 63% Does not attend meetings.
- 3) 50% held previous office.
- 4) 42% held previous activity chair.
- 5) 14% are willing to be an activity chairman in 2005.
- 6) 20% of eligible members willing to run for office in 2005.
- 7) Reasons for joining (some knights chose more than one reason): 37% Fellowship, 63% Faith, 32% Service to community, 12% Family.
- 8) Total number of events per year members can help with: 34% 0-1, 29% 2-3, 9% 4-5, 2% 6-7, 14% over 7.
- 9) Church Parish: 54% St. George, 21% Our Lady of Mercy, 5% St. Patrick, 2% Most Blessed Sacrament, 4% St. Jude, 14% other (St. Jean Vianney, St. Thomas More, etc.)
- 10) Best way to get information (some knights chose more than one reason): 66% Bulletin, 44% Internet.
- 11) Other Ministries some knights chose more than one reason): 23% Eucharistic Minister, 7% Lecturer, 30% Usher, 7% Scouting, 30% other.
- 12) Most convenient night to meet: 43% Tuesday, 9% Wednesday, 6% Thursday, 6% Other.
