**My Brother Knights** - The Knights of Columbus recently completed its 128<sup>th</sup> Supreme Convention in Washington D.C. In his annual report addressed to the delegates, Supreme Knight Carl Anderson made these points concerning the Insurance Program in 2009:

- The Knights of Columbus climbed to no. 929 on the Fortune 1000 of America's largest corporations and ranks no. 49<sup>th</sup> among U.S Life Insurance Companies according to A.B. Best.
- Last year was the best ever for insurance sales, growing by 13.3 percent, even as the industry as a whole was shrinking by nearly 5 percent.
- 67,945 new insurance certificates were issued which was more than all other fraternal societies combined.
- More than double the number of annuity certificates were issued than in 2008.
